SEZF PROPOSAL: The Southeastern Zonal Forum met on February 13, 2022 and unanimously approved the following proposal: "To send an invitation to the Northeast and Autonomy Zonal Forums asking them to participate in a workgroup to discuss combining the three zones into a single Eastern States Zone. This workgroup will bring back recommendations and/or alternatives to each of the zones for their review and/or approval by the member regions in the zones. The workgroup will be made up of three members from each zone, selected by each zone. The workgroup meetings will rotate among each of the zones, facilitated by the hosting zonal facilitator. Voting participants in the workgroup will be the nine zonally-selected members, and NA members in the zones are encouraged to participate and will have a voice."
